



Rules of The Friends of BAYOC 100 Club

The object of the 100 club is to raise funds for The Friends of Basingstoke Area Youth Orchestras and Choirs which exists to carry out fundraising activities. Thus generating financial support & assistance for all nine musical ensembles enabling concerts to take place in 'The Anvil' or groups to partake in residential weekends and overseas tours at reduced rates.

Application to join The Friends of BAYOC 100 Club is in writing only on the official application form and is open to all parents, carers and supporters of the Basingstoke Area Youth Orchestras and Choirs.

All applicants must be aged 16 or over.

The numbers will be allocated in chronological order by the secretary of The Friends of BAYOC 100 Club.

The membership is payable by quarterly standing order, at a rate of £15.00 per quarter per number allocated, ordinarily payable on 5th September, 5th December, 5th March and the 5th June.

A maximum of 50% of the monies collected each quarter will be available as prizes and the value of the prizes will vary with the number of participants.

All prizes will be payable by cheque. No cash will be given out.

Quarterly prizes will be awarded as follows:

One 1st prize;

One 2nd prize;

One 3rd prize;

Four 4th prizes;

Five 5th prizes, and

Ten 6th prizes.

Until there are at least 100 numbers in the 100 Club no 6th prizes will be awarded.

Your number(s) will only be entered into the draws for which advance payment has been received directly into The Friends of BAYOC 100 Club bank account in accordance with the standing order mandate.

Membership to The Friends of BAYOC 100 Club is for a minimum of 3 (three) months, i.e. one quarter.

No refunds will be given on subscriptions.

The draws will take place on a roughly quarterly basis at the 4 major events of the year and will be publicised in advance. For example, Christmas Concert (September standing order), February Event (December standing order), Anvil Concert (March standing order) and Summer Concert (June standing order).

The draws will take place at the location of the above concerts & event.

The draws will be conducted by an individual other than an officer of the Friends of BAYOC, but will be witnessed by an officer of The Friends of BAYOC.

Once a prize has been won, the winning number is not eligible for further prizes in that quarter's draw.

A list of the quarter's winners and prizes will be posted on The Friends of BAYOC website and available from the secretary of The Friends of BAYOC 100 Club.

The applicant(s) will indicate on their application form who may collect prizes on their behalf. Any amendments to these representatives will need to be in writing with a signature to the secretary of The Friends of BAYOC 100 Club.

All prizes will need to be signed for by the winner or their nominated representative, except those sent through the post, whereby the winner accepts responsibility for any losses which occur as a result of posting a cheque with the Royal Mail. However, the secretary of The Friends of BAYOC 100 Club will always obtain a certificate of posting as proof of posting the prize.

Unless prizes are collected at the time of the draw, all prizes will be delivered via The Royal Mail to the address given on the application form.

The applicant(s) will be responsible for ensuring that the secretary of The Friends of BAYOC 100 Club is notified of all changes of home address either via email from the email address recorded on the application form or in writing with a signature.

Any changes to an email address will need to be advised to the secretary of The Friends of BAYOC 100 Club in writing with a signature.

Cancellation of your subscription is to be given in writing to secretary of The Friends of BAYOC 100 club and not just by cancellation of your standing order.
